

**College Credit Decision** is the decision to **Accept** or **Decline** your college credit.

If you have Eligible status and you earn a grade of D- or above in your college course, you have **three Credit Decision options** in Spring 2020:

# ACCEPT LETTER GRADE

Final letter grade will appear on your UT

Austin transcript

# ACCEPT PASS CREDIT

"CR", meaning Credit, will appear on your UT Austin transcript

# DECLINE CREDIT

You will not have a UT Austin transcript



When do I make my college credit decision?

Saturday, May 16, at 8:00 a.m. CT through Friday, May 29, at 5:00 p.m. CT



# Where do I make my college credit decision?

- Visit the OnRamps Portal: https://onramps.utexas.edu/portal
- Click My Enrollments, then click the Accept/Decline Credit button.



# What happens if I do not make a college credit decision?

- You cannot change your credit decision after the deadline.
- If you do not make a college credit decision, the following defaults will take place.

FINAL GRADE	DEFAULT DECISION	UT AUSTIN TRANSCRIPT ISSUED
C- or higher	Credit is <b>accepted</b> for a <b>letter grade</b> .	Yes
D+, D, or D-	Credit is <b>declined</b> .	No



### What do I need to know about the Letter Grade option?

- Fulfills core curriculum requirements at UT Austin if grade is a C- or above (except College Algebra, Chemistry lab, and Physics lab)
- Factors into GPA at UT Austin; other universities may or may not use grade as part of GPA
- **Guaranteed** to transfer to other public universities in Texas if grade is a C- or above and a UT Austin core course
- Fulfills prerequisite requirements, if minimum required grade is met

## What do I need to know about the Pass Credit option?

- **Fulfills** core curriculum requirements at UT Austin for Spring 2020 only (except College Algebra, Chemistry lab, and Physics lab); other universities have their own policies
- Does not factor into GPA at UT Austin; other universities have their own policies
- May not transfer to other public universities in Texas
- May not fulfill prerequisite requirements

#### What if I do not earn credit in the course?

If you did not earn a D- or above in the college course, you do not have to take action. No grade will be reported to the UT Austin Registrar, and you will not have a college transcript.

## How do I request a transcript for the course?

If you earn and accept college credit, you may request a transcript from the UT Austin Registrar in June. You will receive an email with instructions when your transcript is available.

If you decline college credit or do not earn college credit, you may request a letter of non-enrollment from OnRamps Support to provide with college applications or registration.

# IMPORTANT TRANSFER CREDIT INFORMATION

Each college has its own policies about transfer credit, such as whether transfer credit is factored into your GPA or how Pass ("CR") credit transfers. Some colleges have special policies for Spring 2020 credit.

We encourage you to research credit transfer policies at any college or university you may attend before making a decision.
