Parking Lot Rules and Regulations

GENERAL INFORMATION:

- 1. A student parking permit is required at NBHS. Permit Fee: <u>\$10</u>
- Parking permit applications are online. You will need: valid DL#, license plate number, type/color vehicle, and \$10 fee.
- 2. Parking permit must be visible at all times. Permits should be placed above the vehicle registration on the left-hand side.
- 3. Vehicle must be parked legally at all times.
- 4. Speed limit on campus is **10 mph.**
- 5. Once on campus, vehicle will remain parked in designated area until the end of student's school day.
- 6. Loitering in the parking lots before, during or after school is not allowed.
- 7. Students are not allowed to go to their vehicle during the school day without obtaining a parking lot pass from the back office.
- 8. All school rules apply while driving or parking on campus. Driving to and parking at school is a privilege. For repeated or severe infractions, parking privileges can be suspended or revoked at principal's discretion without refund.
- Vehicles parked on campus are under the jurisdiction of the school. School officials may search any vehicle any time there is a reasonable suspicion to do so, with or without the student's permission. The student has full responsibility for the contents of his/her vehicle and must make certain it is locked and the keys are not given to others.

There will be NO individual assigned parking spaces for students. Parking is on a first come, first served basis.

PARKING LOT VIOLATIONS:

- 1. Parking in unauthorized areas, including but not limited to fire lanes, faculty parking, visitor parking, handicapped parking, & grass areas.
- 2. Speeding Speed Limit on campus is 10 mph.
- 3. Racing, dragging, revving engines, or other reckless driving.
- 4. Operating your vehicle on campus during school hours for purposes other than arriving or departing campus.
- 5. Students are not allowed to have people in the open back, on hood or sideboards of a vehicle while the vehicle is in motion.
- 6. Not reporting to the school any accident or damage to another vehicle that you've caused. This includes leaving the scene of an accident.

CONSEQUENCES FOR STUDENTS WITH A PARKING PERMIT:

- If student is illegally parked:
 - 1st offense parking ticket, \$5 fee
 - 2nd offense parking ticket, \$10 fee
 - 3rd offense parking ticket, \$15 fee
 - 4th offense parking ticket, \$20 fee and loss of parking privileges for the semester.
 - If student continues to park illegally after their 4th offense, other disciplinary actions could be taken at the principal's discretion
- For all other violations of the NBHS Parking Lot Rules and Regulations:
 - students are subject to consequences listed in the Student Code of Conduct

CONSEQUNECES FOR STUDENTS WITHOUT A PARKING PERMIT:

- Any vehicle, anywhere on campus, <u>without</u> a current year parking permit is subject to being towed at owner's expense.
- For all other violations of the NBHS Parking Lot Rules and Regulations:
 - students are subject to consequences listed in the Student Code of Conduct
